## SCHOOL DIVISIONS AND CATEGORIES

<b>Elementary</b>	• Female/Male	Pom, Jazz, Hip Hop, High Kick
<b>Junior High</b>	• Female/Male	Pom, Jazz, Hip Hop, High Kick
<b>Junior Varsity</b>	• Female/Male	Pom, Jazz, Hip Hop, High Kick
<b>Varsity</b>	• Female/Male	Pom, Jazz, Hip Hop, High Kick

Division Guidelines: All Teams in the Varsity, Junior Varsity, Junior High and Elementary divisions must be an official school dance team. The Junior Varsity Division is any official school dance team that is recognized by their school as the Junior Varsity or "B" team.

## SCHOOL TEAM PARTICIPATION

*NEW! There is no limitation on the number of team members. If teams perform in more than one category, they must have the same number of dancers in both categories. NEW this year, teams may switch out a designated number of dancers between categories. Teams who have 14 or less dancers, can swap out up to 2 dancers. Teams how have 15 or more dancers can swap out up to 4 dancers. However, you must have the same number of dancer in both routines. Exception: If your team chooses pom as one of your categories, male dancers are not required to perform in pom. If male dancers do choose to perform in pom, they are not required to hold poms.*
